



Margaret Llewellyn (wife of Edward Thomas) was left her husband to become “housekeeper” to James (Siamps) Thomas in 1871 and 1881.

Alfred Embry owned/rented Cross Farm, Llanedarne in 1891. He lived there with his sister Maria married to John Sutton who farmed the land.

1901 Cross Farm occupied by James (Siamps) Thomas and he is living there with Mary and some of her children.

Arthur Hollingshead first married Elizabeth Thomas but ran away to New Zealand with her sister Mary Ann, kidnapping his own son to take with them. Arthur and Elizabeth were later divorced and then he and Mary Ann returned to UK and married – they had children of their own
